The first call for proposals from the IS MIRRI21 Transnational access (TNA) programme opens on 25th January 2021

The first call under the Transnational Access programme of IS_MIRRI21 will soon be launched on 25 January 2021. This call for proposals invites users from research organisations and companies (in the fields of biotechnology, agro-food, pharmaceuticals, environment, etc.) to apply for funded access to one or several of the 14 IS_MIRRI21 partners facilities across Europe. The TNA offers on-site and remote access to a wide variety of microbial resources and facilities to conduct scientific studies. The [TNA online portal](#) is now available with full details on the eligibility, access providers, submission and reporting rules and guides, and more. Applicants are required to contact the access officer (tna@mirri.org) for pre-feasibility evaluation of their projects prior to the submission of the proposal.
